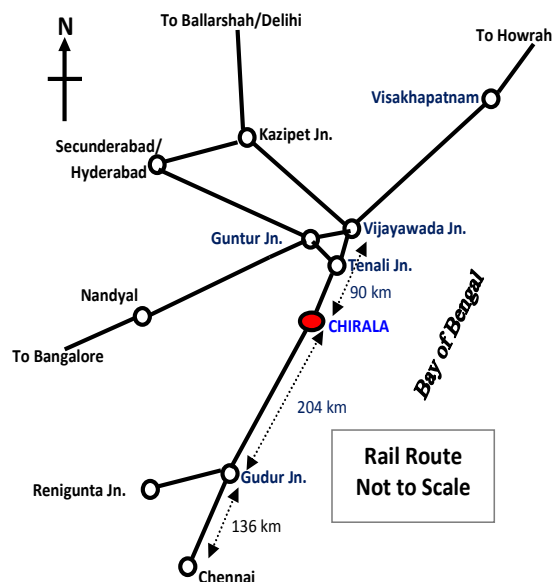


The College is located on Vodarevu Road at a distance of 3 km from Chirala Railway Station and Bus Station and can be reached by auto rickshaws.

How to reach Chirala?

Chirala is on the Chennai - Howrah Railway line, 340 km north of Chennai; 90 km south of Vijayawada on the coromandel coast of peninsular India and can be reached by all important Mail/Express trains including Intercity / Janasatabdi trains that ply between Vijayawada - Chennai- Vijayawada. Chirala can be reached by roadways from Vijayawada (100 km) by AP State Road Transport Corporation Buses via Guntur. The nearest Airstrip is at Gannavaram (Vijayawada)-120 km.
